Her very appreciated books are *Persuasions of the Witch's Craft: Ritual Magic in Contemporary England* (1989); *When God Talks Back: Understanding the American evangelical relationship with God* (2012); *Our Most Troubling Madness: Schizophrenia and Culture* (2016) and others.
